

## Plug Pull AA6310

### Description

A self adhesive plastic moulded T-piece which fixes to the back of a standard three pin plug. This provides leverage when removing the plug from the socket. It is made from a non-conducting plastic and is also useful for drawers and doors.

### Installation

Note: Once stuck the plug pull cannot be removed.

1. Clean the surface of the plug with a damp cloth and a household cleaner avoiding moisture running into the plug. Dry thoroughly.
2. Peel the protective cover off the adhesive pad on the plug pull. Position on the plug and press on firmly, allow time to bond before using.

### Cleaning and Care

Clean with a damp cloth and a mild solution of disinfectant and detergent. Avoid solution running into the plug and dry thoroughly.
